5 exceptional students as Distinguished College Scholars on Honors
6 Day; Distinguished College Scholars rank in the top four percent of

8 in-residence cumulative grade point average; students must have
9 completed at least 30 semester hours of course work in residence and
10 at least 60 hours of college course work overall, including
