range of other positive developments for area residents; and

4 WHEREAS, Commonly known as free running, parkour developed

5 out of military obstacle-course training as a method of traveling

6 from point to point with quick, efficient body movements;

7 participants surmount barriers by various methods, including

8 running, climbing, vaulting, jumping, and rolling; and
