RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Friends, loved ones, and television fans across the 2 nation will forever treasure their memories of actor Sherman Hemsley, who died in El Paso on July 24, 2012, at the age of 74; and 3 WHEREAS, Born in Philadelphia on February 1, 1938, Sherman 4 5 Alexander Hemsley studied as a teenager at the Philadelphia Academy of Dramatic Arts; he dropped out of high school to serve in the 6 U.S. Air Force for four years, then returned to Philadelphia to 7 work for the U.S. Post Office while continuing to study acting at 8

night; and WHEREAS, Mr. Hemsley moved to New York to pursue an acting 10 11 career, and as a member of the Negro Ensemble Company and the Urban Arts Company, he appeared in a number of productions, including The 12 Lottery, Old Judge Mose Is Dead, and Step Lively Boys; in 1970, he 13 14 made his Broadway debut as Gitlow in the musical Purlie; and

WHEREAS, During a national tour of the show, Mr. Hemsley was 15 16 approached by television producer Norman Lear to play a character on the groundbreaking situation comedy All in the Family; he joined 17 the cast in 1973 as the blustering and pompous George Jefferson; 18 this character and his wife, Louise, played by Isabel Sanford, were 19 such a success that they became the stars of their own show, The 20 21 Jeffersons, which ran for 11 seasons, earning Mr. Hemsley nominations for the Emmy and the Golden Globe; and 22

23 WHEREAS, The Jeffersons went off the air in 1985, and 24 Mr. Hemsley went on to play a scheming church deacon on the sitcom

- 1 Amen, voice a triceratops on the live-action puppet series,
- 2 Dinosaurs, and make guest appearances on The Fresh Prince of
- 3 Bel-Air, Sister, Sister, Family Guy, and Tyler Perry's House of
- 4 Payne; as one of the most beloved fictional couples in TV history,
- 5 he and Ms. Sanford reprised their signature roles in commercials
- 6 for The Gap, Old Navy, and Denny's, and they toured together in the
- 7 stage show The Real Live Jeffersons; he was inducted into the
- 8 Television Hall of Fame in 2012; and
- 9 WHEREAS, In later years, Mr. Hemsley, who was more reserved
- 10 than the character who made him famous, enjoyed a quiet life in El
- 11 Paso, where he made many friends and became active in local
- 12 charities; after his death, befitting his service to his country,
- 13 he was buried with military honors at Fort Bliss National Cemetery;
- 14 and
- WHEREAS, A gifted and energetic performer on the stage and
- 16 the screen, Sherman Hemsley was in private life a modest and deeply
- 17 spiritual man who took great pleasure in music and the company of
- 18 his friends, and he leaves behind a legacy of laughter that
- 19 continues to delight countless fans; now, therefore, be it
- 20 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 83rd Texas
- 21 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life and career of Sherman
- 22 Hemsley and extend sincere condolences to his friends and loved
- 23 ones; and, be it further
- 24 RESOLVED, That when the Texas House of Representatives
- 25 adjourns this day, it do so in memory of Sherman Hemsley.
