WHEREAS, This longtime educator has been praised for her dedication to her students, her kindness, and her emphasis on bilingualism in her classroom; now 89, Ms. Moreno was recognized for her many contributions to the community at the March celebration, which was held at the Kleberg Elementary School library; and
