1           WHEREAS, Bill Johnson of Wimberley is marking a special  
2 milestone in his life with the observance of his 90th birthday on  
3 May 25, 2013; and

4           WHEREAS, Born in Houston in 1923, William Parks Johnson  
5 served his country in the United States Marine Corps during World  
6 War II; he was wounded in the Battle of Iwo Jima and subsequently  
7 received the Purple Heart; later, he attended The University of  
8 Texas at Austin, and as a student he met and married Mary Frances  
9 Brown; they have now shared more than 60 years as husband and wife;

11           WHEREAS, Mr. Johnson began farming and ranching in the  
12 Wimberley area in the 1940s; at about that same time, he also helped  
13 to establish Camp Longhorn, and during the 35 years that he served  
14 as camp director, this esteemed Texan mentored thousands of  
15 children and young adults; though he retired in 1978, Mr. Johnson  
16 continues to play an active role in his community, where he has been  
17 instrumental in the founding of a new church; moreover, he is an  
18 expert in the history of the area and the author of numerous books;  
19 above all, he cherishes his family, which has grown to include five  
20 children, Lynn, Jock, Clay, Blake, and Scott, and three  
21 grandchildren, Caraline, Lauren, and Andrew; and

22           WHEREAS, Bill Johnson is a treasured source of wisdom and an  
23 inspiration to all who know him, and it is a pleasure to honor him on  
24 nine decades of life well lived; now, therefore, be it
