R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, The girls' track and field team of McGregor High  
2 School won the District 15-2A championship with a fine showing in  
3 the district meet on April 10, 2013; and

4           WHEREAS, In capturing the title, the Lady Bulldogs benefited  
5 from an outstanding performance by Latecia Irons, who won the  
6 200-meter dash, placed second in the long jump, and helped her  
7 school to attain two relay triumphs; in the 400-meter race, she  
8 joined with teammates VaRonika Loreda, Devon Norwood, and Kailyn  
9 Harmel to claim the victory, and in the 1,600, she, Ms. Harmel,  
10 Ashley Fehlman, and Samantha Lenamon were first across the finish  
11 line; and

12           WHEREAS, Ms. Harmel placed second in the 100 hurdles while  
13 Ms. Fehlman and Ms. Lenamon took second and third, respectively, in  
14 the 800-meter competition; McGregor athletes were impressive in  
15 several additional field events as well, with Ms. Lenamon earning  
16 third place in the high jump, and Angela Rost finishing second in  
17 the shot put and third in the discus; and

18           WHEREAS, Guided by head coach Stacy Ainsworth, the Lady  
19 Bulldogs tallied a total score of 132 in the final team standings,  
20 outpacing the second-place Crawford High squad by 13.5 points to  
21 take home the trophy; and

22           WHEREAS, Winning a district championship represents the  
23 culmination of countless hours of hard work and an unwavering  
24 commitment to excellence, and the members of the McGregor girls'

1 track and field team may indeed take pride in this memorable  
2 achievement; now, therefore, be it
