R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, Wade Emmert of Cedar Hill has rendered notable  
2 service to his community through his professional and civic  
3 endeavors; and

4           WHEREAS, A Midland native, Mr. Emmert earned his bachelor's  
5 degree in business and international studies from Abilene Christian  
6 University in 1992 and his juris doctorate from Baylor Law School in  
7 1995; he is currently a partner in the law firm of Burford & Ryburn,  
8 L.L.P., where he practices corporate law and civil litigation; he  
9 has been recognized as a Texas Super Lawyer by *Texas Monthly* and by
