11 board of the Richardson Chamber of Commerce in 1998, and for his

13 organization; a man of faith and always looking to help others, he
14 volunteered with the employment transition ministry and the senior
15 youth group at First United Methodist Church of Richardson; and

16 WHEREAS, Above all, Mr. Peters cherished his two daughters,
17 Erica and Brooke; and

18 WHEREAS, While the death of David Peters has brought great
19 sadness to his loved ones, he leaves behind a legacy that will
20 forever be treasured by all those who shared in the blessing of his
