WHEREAS, A graduate of Incarnate Word Academy in Corpus

Christi, Mrs. McGloin worked for many years with the United Way of

of development; she raised two adored sons, Phillip and Andy, and

8 later welcomed into her family four grandchildren; and

9 WHEREAS, Mrs. McGloin, whose roots in Texas extended back to 10 the days of the Republic, was passionate about history; as a member

11 of the Nueces County Historical Commission, she helped to restore

12 and preserve the Old Bayview Cemetery, as well as to develop a

website for the burial ground; she also served on the board of the

14 Corpus Christi Area Heritage Society, during which time she

15 assisted in overseeing renovations to the Centennial House, and on

16 the board of the Nueces County Historical Society, which honored

17 her with the Daniel E. Kilgore Local History Award; in addition, she

18 played an important role in locating and acquiring for the Corpus

19 Christi Museum one of the earliest paintings of the city, a

20 watercolor made by British artist Thomas Flintoff in 1852; and

21 WHEREAS, Deeply involved in the life of her church, Mrs.

22 McGloin wrote numerous articles for the South Texas Catholic, a

23 publication of the Roman Catholic diocese of Corpus Christi, and

24 she performed research for the book marking the diocese's
