1           WHEREAS, A life filled with meaningful accomplishments drew  
2 to a close with the passing of David George Luckstead of Corpus  
3 Christi on March 14, 2013, at the age of 81; and

4           WHEREAS, Born in 1931 in Charlotte, Iowa, Mr. Luckstead was  
5 the son of Edwin and Luella Luckstead; he served in the United  
6 States Army as a combat engineer and a paratrooper, and he later  
7 earned a bachelor's degree in chemical engineering from Iowa State  
8 University, where he was a member of the Tau Beta Pi honor society;  
9 he settled in Corpus Christi around 1960 and earned his living for  
10 many years as a financial consultant; and

11           WHEREAS, Mr. Luckstead was preceded in death by his wife, Eva  
12 Sanchez Luckstead, and he was the father of six children, Erica,  
13 Mark, Linda, Lee, Jon, and Lisa; with the passing years, his family  
14 grew to include three grandchildren, Joanna, Daniel, and Hayden;

16           WHEREAS, Mr. Luckstead took great enjoyment in travel and had  
17 the opportunity to visit Monaco, Brazil, and South Africa; other  
18 highlights of his life included his efforts to help found the Corpus  
19 Christi Botanical Gardens and his participation in walkathons on  
20 Padre Island; and

21           WHEREAS, David Luckstead treasured the time he spent in the  
22 company of his family and friends, and those he leaves behind will  
23 in turn cherish their memories of this kind and caring man, who  
24 shared many wonderful stories with them through the years; now,

3 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the memory of David George  
4 Luckstead and extend sincere sympathy to the members of his family:
