1 WHEREAS, Adan Gonzalez of Dallas won the Men's 165 Elite
2 Division title at the 2013 United States Intercollegiate Boxing
3 Association National Championship Tournament, held April 11-13 in
4 San Francisco; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Gonzalez first started boxing at the age of
6 nine, introduced to the sport by his father, and he flourished in
7 the sweet science from the outset; now the cocaptain of the
8 Georgetown University club boxing team, he was the only Hoyas
9 fighter to win a title at the championships, where he triumphed over
10 national finalist Sebastian Doerner of the University of San
11 Francisco; and

12 WHEREAS, This outstanding Texas athlete has excelled in the
13 classroom as well; he was a straight-A student at W. H. Adamson High
14 School in Dallas, where he was voted 2011 Student of the Year by
15 Junior Achievement, and his academic excellence earned him a full
16 scholarship to Georgetown; Mr. Gonzalez is the first member of his
17 family to attend college, and he is hopeful that his achievements
18 will help encourage others to pursue higher education; and

19 WHEREAS, By proving himself one of the finest collegiate
20 boxers in the United States, Adan Gonzalez has established himself
21 as an exceptional athlete and an inspiring role model, and his
22 accomplishment is a source of great pride to his family and his
23 community; now, therefore, be it

1 Legislature hereby congratulate Adan Gonzalez on capturing the
2 Men's 165 Elite Division title at the 2013 United States
