R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Cheryl Whitfield has demonstrated exceptional
2 patriotism through her efforts in behalf of fallen members of the
3 United States military; and

4 WHEREAS, In 2008, Ms. Whitfield founded the National
5 Memorial Ladies; the members of this noteworthy service
6 organization pay tribute to Texans who made the ultimate sacrifice
7 for our country; in addition to attending military funerals at
8 Houston National Cemetery, volunteers offer condolences to
9 bereaved families; and

10 WHEREAS, Ms. Whitfield has continued to work diligently to
11 remind her fellow citizens of the contributions of the brave men and
12 women of the armed forces; in 2010, she began a fund-raising effort
13 to create a monument honoring Texans who gave their lives in defense
14 of the United States of America in Operation Iraqi Freedom and
15 Operation New Dawn in Iraq and Operation Enduring Freedom in
16 Afghanistan; she collaborated with public officials to find a site
17 for the monument, which was built in Cy-Champ Park and dedicated on
18 October 6, 2012; it features four large granite walls engraved with
19 the names of more than 600 soldiers; and

20 WHEREAS, Time can never diminish the profound debt Americans
21 owe to the heroes who have died to protect our liberty, and Cheryl
22 Whitfield has given selflessly of her time and talent to ensure that
23 their courage and sacrifice receive due recognition; now,
24 therefore, be it

1 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 83rd Texas
2 Legislature hereby commend Cheryl Whitfield for her leadership in
3 the establishment of the National Memorial Ladies organization and
4 the Fallen Warriors Memorial in Cy-Champ Park and extend to her
5 sincere best wishes for continued success in her important
