R E S O L U T I O N

2 Internship Program, has rendered outstanding service in the office

5           WHEREAS, Established in 1990 and administered by the Mickey  
6 Leland Center on World Hunger and Peace at Texas Southern  
7 University, TLIP provides a unique opportunity for students from  
8 Texas colleges and universities to serve as interns in the Texas  
9 Legislature, in state agencies, and in local government offices;

11           WHEREAS, Mr. Austin earned a bachelor's degree in psychology  
12 in 2011 from the University of Central Arkansas; while a student  
13 there, he was the philanthropy chair and vice president of  
14 communications for Sigma Phi Epsilon fraternity, and he was active

16           WHEREAS, Now enrolled at the Thurgood Marshall School of Law  
17 at TSU, Mr. Austin is a member of the Public Service Committee of  
18 the Public Interest Law Association and served as a volunteer judge  
19 for the American Mock Trial Association Houston Regional  
20 Tournament; he previously gained experience as a legal intern with  
21 the Gulf Region Advocacy Center, where he helped prepare defenses  
22 for capital crimes and also worked on sentence mitigation; and

23           WHEREAS, Glen Austin has skillfully handled a variety of  
24 duties in the office of Representative Alonzo, and he may indeed
