R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, For more than a century, the Boy Scouts of America
2 has helped young men build character, become responsible citizens,
3 and develop their abilities in a wide range of pursuits, and those
4 scouts who advance through the program to its highest rank are
5 rewarded with the Eagle Scout insignia; and

6 WHEREAS, Only about five percent of all Boy Scouts earn the
7 title of Eagle Scout, and Cullen Quinn of Lubbock may now count
8 himself in that select group; in order to obtain that notable honor,
9 specific requirements in the areas of leadership, service, and
10 outdoor skills must be met; Eagle Scouts need to earn at least 21
11 merit badges, including those in first aid, camping, personal
12 fitness, environmental science, and citizenship; an Eagle Scout
13 must also serve as a leader both in his troop and in the completion
14 of a project that is beneficial to a school, religious institution,
15 or community; and

16 WHEREAS, A senior at Coronado High School, Mr. Quinn has
17 excelled academically, earning induction into the National Honor
18 Society and recognition as a Lubbock Independent School District
19 Superintendent's Scholar; he has volunteered his time to benefit
20 the library, Vacation Bible School, and Meals on Wheels, and in 2011
21 he organized an effort to collect and mail 34 boxes of clothes to
22 orphans in Afghanistan; and

23 WHEREAS, The Eagle Scout program fosters self-reliance,
24 initiative, and resourcefulness, and those same qualities that

1 enable a scout to attain this prestigious rank will be invaluable
2 assets to him on the road ahead; now, therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 83rd Texas
4 Legislature hereby congratulate Eagle Scout Cullen Quinn on his
5 outstanding achievement and extend to him sincere best wishes for
6 continued success in all his endeavors; and, be it further

7 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
8 prepared for Eagle Scout Quinn as an expression of high regard by
9 the Texas House of Representatives.
