9 Zenteno Band with her brothers, Javier, Bobby, and Ernie, and their
10 group went on to enjoy decades of success performing Latin, jazz,
11 and rock music in Houston; and

12 WHEREAS, Ms. Zenteno was the devoted wife of Stephen Shaw and
13 the loving mother of four children, Angela, Victor, Anthony, and
14 Miles, and two stepchildren, Logan and Nicole; and

15 WHEREAS, Through her consummate musical artistry, Norma
16 Zenteno brought joy to innumerable people, and those who were
17 blessed to share in the richness of her life will forever hold her
