R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The observance of Texas Federation for Republican
2 Outreach Legislative Day at the State Capitol on May 23, 2013,
3 provides a fitting opportunity to recognize Bill Calhoun for his
4 outstanding service as chair of this noteworthy organization; and

5 WHEREAS, Established in 1986 as the Black Republican Council
6 of Texas, the Texas Federation for Republican Outreach is an
7 auxiliary of the Republican Party of Texas that recruits African
8 American voters as Republican precinct chairs in Harris and Fort
