

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The observance of Texas Federation for Republican
2 Outreach Legislative Day at the State Capitol on May 23, 2013,
3 provides a fitting opportunity to recognize Zoia Jones of Houston
4 for more than two decades of distinguished service as a Republican
5 Party precinct chair; and

6 WHEREAS, Established in 1986 as the Black Republican Council
7 of Texas, the Texas Federation for Republican Outreach is an
8 auxiliary of the Republican Party of Texas that recruits African
9 American voters as Republican precinct chairs in Harris and Fort

23 the nation, and they may take justifiable pride in their admirable
