R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The observance of Texas Federation for Republican  
2 Outreach Legislative Day at the State Capitol on May 23, 2013,  
3 provides a fitting opportunity to recognize the notable service of  
4 Clyde Lemon of Houston as a former Republican Party precinct chair;

6 WHEREAS, Established in 1986 as the Black Republican Council  
7 of Texas, the Texas Federation for Republican Outreach is an  
8 auxiliary of the Republican Party of Texas that recruits African  
9 American voters as Republican precinct chairs in Harris and Fort  
10 Bend Counties; citizens who have participated in this initiative  
11 come from a wide range of backgrounds, but they share common values,  
12 including devotion to family, faith, and freedom, and they strive  
13 together to promote increased diversity in the party; and

14 WHEREAS, Precinct chairs serve as the ambassadors of their

17 serve as election judges in primary and general elections; these  
18 civic-minded individuals are integral to the success of the party's  
19 mission to elect public servants who will build a better tomorrow;

21 WHEREAS, Through their involvement, precinct chairs are  
22 making a positive difference in their communities, this state, and  
23 the nation, and they may take justifiable pride in their admirable  
24 record of civic engagement; now, therefore, be it

1           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 83rd Texas  
2 Legislature hereby commend Clyde Lemon for serving as a former  
3 Republican Party precinct chair and extend to this outstanding  
4 Texan sincere best wishes for the future; and, be it further
