R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, Cameron Lee Alexander of Boy Scouts of America Troop  
2 No. 840 in Deer Park has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, and this  
3 accomplishment truly merits special recognition; and

4           WHEREAS, Receiving the Eagle Scout badge is a significant  
5 honor, bestowed on only a small fraction of those who enter the  
6 scouting movement; in the course of meeting the rank's demanding  
7 criteria, Mr. Alexander earned the requisite 21 merit badges and  
8 successfully completed an Eagle Scout project, which involved  
9 organizing the construction of obstacles to train dogs in the  
10 Canine Unit of the Pasadena Police Department; moreover, he earned  
11 the Scouting Heroism Award for saving the life of a relative; and

13 Texan has distinguished himself as a member of the National and  
14 German National Honor Societies, and he was named an AP Scholar with  
15 Honors by the College Board; he was president of the Robotics Club  
16 and helped his school's University Interscholastic League robotics  
17 team qualify for the state championship, and he was twice awarded  
18 top honors in the UIL Computer Science district competition; he is  
19 currently a student at the University of Houston; and

20           WHEREAS, Eagle Scout Alexander's dedication to excellence  
21 and his perseverance in the pursuit of his goals have proven him  
22 worthy to stand among scouting's elite, and he may indeed reflect  
23 with pride on a job well done; now, therefore, be it
