R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The NEW Leadership Texas program is being held at
2 The University of Texas at Austin from May 30 to June 4, 2013; and

3 WHEREAS, Hosted by the UT Center for Women's and Gender
4 Studies, with support from the Embrey Family Foundation, NEW
5 Leadership Texas is a nonpartisan intensive residential program
6 that educates college women about politics and policy-making and
7 encourages them to get involved in the political process; the
8 program was developed in part by the NEW Leadership Development
9 Network, a national partnership that currently includes 21 colleges
10 and universities and that is based at the Center for American Women
11 and Politics at Rutgers University; and
