1 WHEREAS, The boys' 1,600-meter relay team from Glen Rose High
2 School achieved great distinction by qualifying for the 2013
3 University Interscholastic League Track & Field State Meet; and

4 WHEREAS, Team members Blake Eschbach, Ryan Lamb, Carter
5 Brandt, and Nathan Smith earned their place in the state
6 competition with an exceptional performance at the 3A Region I
7 meet, held April 26 and 27 in Lubbock; the squad finished first and
8 recorded a time of 3 minutes, 20.24 seconds, the second-fastest
9 time among the 3A regional qualifiers; and

10 WHEREAS, Aably guided by coach Todd Swarengin, the Glen Rose
11 runners became the first Tigers boys' relay team to reach the state
12 meet; they took their place alongside the other top 3A squads at
13 Mike A. Myers Stadium in Austin on May 11, where they finished

16 commitment to excellence, these dedicated student-athletes earned
17 the right to compete at the highest level of their sport, and their
18 accomplishment is a source of pride to their school and their many
