- 1 WHEREAS, Words cannot adequately express the sorrow felt at 2 the loss of U.S. Army Specialist Brandon Joseph Prescott of Bend,
- 3 Oregon, who died in Afghanistan on May 4, 2013, at the age of 24; and
- WHEREAS, Assigned to the 1st Brigade Combat Team, 1st
- 5 Battalion, 36th Infantry, 1st Armored Division out of Fort Bliss,
- 6 Specialist Prescott was one of five soldiers killed when their
- 7 vehicle was struck by an improvised explosive device in Maiwand,
- 8 Afghanistan; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Brandon Prescott was born in West Covina,
- 10 California, on July 18, 1988, to Tracey Prescott and Joseph
- 11 Prescott; he grew up in Dana Point, California, where he graduated
- 12 from Dana Hills High School in 2006; two years later, he moved with
- 13 his family to Bend, where he studied at Central Oregon Community
- 14 College, volunteered with the Federal Emergency Management Agency,
- 15 and took part in a firefighting academy; and
- WHEREAS, In 2010, Specialist Prescott enlisted in the army
- 17 and trained at Fort Benning, Georgia; his first assignment was to
- 18 Fort Bliss, where he was selected as assistant team leader for his
- 19 unit of the Reconnaissance Platoon and deployed to Afghanistan in
- 20 support of Operation Enduring Freedom; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Specialist Prescott's commendations include the
- 22 Bronze Star Medal, the Purple Heart, the Army Commendation Medal
- 23 with Valor device, the Army Good Conduct Medal, the Global War on
- 24 Terrorism Service Medal, the National Defense Service Medal, the

- 1 Afghanistan Campaign Medal with a campaign star, the NATO Medal,
- 2 and the Combat Infantryman Badge; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Although the tragic death of this brave young man is
- 4 a sobering reminder of the cost of war, Brandon Prescott embodied
- 5 the highest ideals of the U.S. armed forces, and those who knew and
- 6 loved him will forever carry him close in their hearts; now,
- 7 therefore, be it

- 9 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of U.S. Army Specialist
