- 2 the loss of U.S. Army Staff Sergeant Francis Gene Phillips IV of
- 3 Meridian, New York, who died in Afghanistan on May 4, 2013, at the
- 4 age of 28; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Assigned to the 1st Brigade Combat Team, 1st
- 6 Battalion, 36th Infantry, 1st Armored Division out of Fort Bliss,
- 7 Staff Sergeant Phillips was one of five soldiers killed when their
- 8 vehicle was struck by an improvised explosive device in Maiwand,
- 9 Afghanistan; and
- WHEREAS, Frankie Phillips was born in Oakland, California, on
- 11 August 18, 1984, to Francis G. Phillips III and Cherie Forslund
- 12 Phillips; after graduating from Oceanside High School, he moved
- 13 with his family to Meridian, New York, and then to nearby Auburn in
- 14 2003; he enlisted in the army in 2004 and trained at Fort Benning,
- 15 Georgia; in 2005, he was deployed to Iraq, and in 2007, he began a
- 16 15-month deployment to Afghanistan, returning in 2009 for 12 more
- 17 months; after training at the Ranger School, Staff Sergeant
- 18 Phillips was stationed at Fort Bliss, and in December 2012, he
- 19 returned to Afghanistan as the Reconnaissance Platoon team leader;
- 20 and
- 21 WHEREAS, His commendations include the Bronze Star Medal, the
- 22 Purple Heart, the Army Commendation Medal with Valor device, the
- 23 Army Commendation Medal with one oak leaf cluster, the Army
- 24 Achievement Medal with two oak leaf clusters, the Army Good Conduct

- 1 Medal with one oak leaf cluster, the Global War on Terrorism Service
- 2 Medal, the National Defense Service Medal, the Iraq Campaign Medal
- 3 with a campaign star, the Afghanistan Campaign Medal with a
- 4 campaign star, the NATO Medal, the Expert Infantryman Badge, the
- 5 Parachutist Badge, and the Combat Infantryman Badge; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Although the tragic death of this brave young man is
- 7 a sobering reminder of the cost of war, Frankie Phillips embodied
- 8 the highest ideals of the U.S. armed forces, and those who knew and
- 9 loved him will forever carry him close in their hearts; now,
