9 WHEREAS, Born on August 26, 1993, in Edinburg, Kevin Cardoza 10 graduated from Edcouch-Elsa High School in 2011 and enlisted in the 11 army that same year; after training at Fort Benning, Georgia, he was 12 assigned to Fort Bliss, and a month later, he was selected to serve 13 as a member of the Reconnaissance Platoon in Afghanistan in support 14 of Operation Enduring Freedom; and

WHEREAS, Specialist Cardoza's commendations include the Bronze Star Medal, the Purple Heart, the Army Good Conduct Medal, the Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, the National Defense Service Medal, the Afghanistan Campaign Medal with a campaign star, the NATO Medal, and the Combat Infantryman Badge; and
