- 1 WHEREAS, Illegal, unreported, and unregulated fishing is a
- 2 global problem with serious economic, environmental, and security
- 3 implications; and
- WHEREAS, Worldwide, illegal fishing accounts for economic
- 5 losses of up to \$23 billion per year; such activity is largely
- 6 conducted by foreign fleets at the expense of United States
- 7 fishermen, coastal communities, and the sustainability of global
- 8 fish stocks; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Illegal fishing is of particular consequence in
- 10 Texas, where the Gulf Coast waters supply seafood for the American
- 11 public and support the hospitality industry, tourism-related
- 12 businesses, and vibrant recreational fishing; not only does illegal
- 13 fishing result in economic losses to the Texas fishing industry and
- 14 other coastal businesses, but it also is a threat to the
- 15 sustainability of our fisheries and to the Texas Gulf Coast
- 16 ecosystem; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Vessels involved with illegal fishing are also
- 18 associated with other crimes, including drug trafficking, human
- 19 trafficking, and illegal immigration, and the incursion by these
- 20 foreign fishing vessels into U.S. waters constitutes a violation of
- 21 our sovereignty; now, therefore, be it
- 22 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 83rd Texas
- 23 Legislature hereby express its commitment to the elimination of
- 24 illegal fishing, to the long-term conservation of Texas marine
