16 WHEREAS, Highly decorated, Colonel Betty has been awarded the 17 Legion of Merit, the Meritorious Service Medal with one Oak Leaf 18 Cluster, the Army Commendation Medal with four Oak Leaf Clusters, 19 the Joint Meritorious Unit Award with one Oak Leaf Cluster, the Army 20 Achievement Medal, the Army Reserve Components Achievement Medal 21 with four Oak Leaf Clusters, and the National Defense Service Medal 22 with two Bronze Service Stars, among many other honors; and

23 WHEREAS, Colonel Betty graduated from Texas A&M University 24 with a bachelor's degree in agricultural economics and a master's

1 degree in educational administration; his affiliation with the 2 university also includes working for the Office of the Commandant 3 in such positions as chief of staff, interim commandant, and deputy 4 commandant; he retired from Texas A&M in 2012; and

5 WHEREAS, Since January 2006, Colonel Betty has served with 6 distinction as a member of the Texas State Guard, most recently, in 7 the J-1 section of headquarters in Austin; at his new rank, he will 8 be the deputy commanding general of the Army Component Command; and

9 WHEREAS, Throughout his endeavors, Colonel Betty has enjoyed 10 the love and support of his wife of 37 years, Juli, as well as their 11 children, Josh and Alison, and his treasured family further 12 includes three grandchildren, Jax, Joy-Lindsey, and Rudder; and

WHEREAS, Colonel Jake Betty has devoted himself to protecting and defending this state and nation for a remarkable four decades, and his promotion to brigadier general represents a resounding vote of confidence in his ability to meet the challenges and opportunities that lie ahead; now, therefore, be it
