7 Leadership Foundation, this program offers outstanding university
8 students and recent graduates an opportunity to serve as full-time
9 policy interns in the offices of members of the Mexican American

21 Martinez Fischer's office, while acquiring knowledge of issues
22 facing citizens of the Lone Star State; she has performed her duties
