R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, David C. Schanbacher is retiring as director of the  
2 Natural Resources Policy Division of the Office of the Texas  
3 Comptroller of Public Accounts on May 31, 2013; and

4 WHEREAS, Since joining the agency in 2009, Mr. Schanbacher  
5 has advised the comptroller on environmental, energy, and  
6 endangered species initiatives that have the potential to affect  
7 state revenues and the Texas economy; he previously served as the  
8 chief engineer for the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality,  
9 where he also had been deputy director of the chief engineer's  
10 office, special assistant to the Office of Air Quality and the  
11 Office of the Executive Director, and a permit engineer in the New  
12 Source Review Program; and

13 WHEREAS, Mr. Schanbacher holds a bachelor's degree in  
14 chemical engineering from the University of Missouri and a master's  
15 degree in electrical engineering from The University of Texas at  
16 Austin; a registered professional engineer, he gained experience in  
17 the chemical and oil and gas industries before entering the public  
18 sector in 1992 as an employee of the Texas Air Control Board; and

19 WHEREAS, David Schanbacher has earned the respect and  
20 appreciation of his coworkers over the course of his tenure in state  
21 government, and he may indeed reflect with pride on a career well  
22 spent as he prepares to embark on the next exciting chapter of his  
23 life; now, therefore, be it
