## RESOLUTION

- BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of
- 2 Texas, 83rd Legislature, Regular Session, 2013, That House Rule 13,
- 3 Section 9(a), be suspended in part as provided by House Rule 13,
- 4 Section 9(f), to enable the conference committee appointed to
- 5 resolve the differences on Senate Bill 1458 (contributions to,
- 6 benefits from, and the administration of systems and programs
- 7 administered by the Teacher Retirement System of Texas) to consider
- 8 and take action on the following matters:
- 9 (1) House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(1), is suspended to permit
- 10 the committee to change, alter, or amend text not in disagreement in
- 11 proposed SECTION 2 of the bill, in added Section 824.702(c),
- 12 Government Code, to read as follows:
- 13 <u>(c) If the annuitant:</u>
- 14 (1) is a retiree, or is a beneficiary under an optional
- 15 retirement payment plan, to be eligible for the adjustment under
- 16 this section:
- 17 (A) the annuitant must be living on the effective
- 18 date of the adjustment; and
- 19 (B) the effective date of the retirement of the
- 20 member of the Teacher Retirement System of Texas must have been on
- 21 or before August 31, 2004;
- 22 (2) is a beneficiary under Section 824.402(a)(3) or
- 23 (4) or 824.502, to be eligible for the adjustment:
- 24 (A) the annuitant must be living on the effective

## 1 date of the adjustment; and

- 2 (B) the date of death of the member of the
- 3 retirement system must have been on or before August 31, 2004; or
- 4 (3) is an alternate payee under Section 804.005, the
- 5 annuitant is eligible for the adjustment only if the effective date
- 6 of the election to receive the annuity payment was on or before
- 7 August 31, 2004.
- 8 Explanation: The change is necessary to ensure that the date
- 9 used to determine eligibility for a cost-of-living adjustment
- 10 across different categories of annuitants under Section 824.702,
- 11 Government Code, is August 31, 2004, instead of August 31, 1999.
- 12 (2) House Rule 13, Sections 9(a)(1) and (3), are suspended
- 13 to permit the committee to change, alter, or amend text on a matter
- 14 not in disagreement and to add text on a matter not in disagreement
- 15 in proposed SECTION 15 of the bill, the effective date provision of
- 16 the bill, to read as follows:
- 17 SECTION 15. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of
- 18 this section, this Act takes effect September 1, 2014.
- 19 (b) Section 824.702, Government Code, as added by this Act,
- 20 Section 825.402, Government Code, as amended by this Act, and the
- 21 repeal by this Act of Section 1579.103, Insurance Code, take effect
- 22 September 1, 2013.
- 23 Explanation: The change in the effective date provision is a
- 24 technical change necessary to ensure that Section 824.702,
- 25 Government Code, adding a cost-of-living adjustment for certain
- 26 annuitants under the Teacher Retirement System of Texas, takes
- 27 effect in time to provide the adjustment provided for under that

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1 section.
