14 WHEREAS, Benefiting the wider community, Dr. Murley served on the airport and school boards alongside his brother, and in 1985, 15 16 they were named Men of the Year by the Winnsboro Area Chamber of Commerce; this multifaceted Texan also found time to maintain his 17 licenses as a pilot and aircraft technician, and he owned a shop at 18 the airport; in addition, he demonstrated a knack for automotive 19 repair by keeping a vintage Mercedes on the road; in all his 20 endeavors, he has enjoyed the love and support of his wife, Lou, and 21 22 their four sons; and

23 WHEREAS, The residents of Winnsboro are indeed fortunate to 24 have been served for so long by such a skillful and compassionate
