16 WHEREAS, Above all else, Mr. Callegari was devoted to his
17 family; he and his wife, Iris, shared 44 years of marriage and
18 became the parents of four treasured children, Steve, Amy, Charles,
19 and Jerome; also inspired and sustained by his strong faith,
20 Mr. Callegari was active in the congregation at The Family Church;
