R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, During the 83rd Regular Session, Arthur Huggins,
2 Jr., has ably served his fellow Texans in the office of State
3 Representative Borris Miles through the Texas Legislative
4 Internship Program; and

5 WHEREAS, Sponsored by Senator Rodney Ellis, TLIP was
6 established in 1990 and is administered by the Mickey Leland Center
7 on World Hunger and Peace at Texas Southern University; the program
8 provides a unique opportunity for students from Texas colleges and
9 universities to serve as interns in the Texas Legislature, in state
10 agencies, and in local government offices; participants receive
11 academic credit for their work with the initiative, which combines
12 study and research with supervised practical training; and

13 WHEREAS, Mr. Huggins is a third-year student at the Thurgood
14 Marshall School of Law at Texas Southern University; he holds a
15 bachelor's degree in criminal justice from the University of
16 Central Florida and has worked at the Earl Carl Institute for Legal
17 and Social Policy at TSU, an advocacy organization that handles
18 issues affecting urban and indigent Americans; and

19 WHEREAS, When he earns his juris doctorate, Mr. Huggins will
20 become the first in his family to receive a law degree, and he plans
21 to focus on commercial transactions and agricultural and government
22 law; he has accepted a position with the office of Houston City
23 Controller Ronald Green; and

24 WHEREAS, This noteworthy Texan has performed his duties as a

1 legislative intern with skill and dedication, and he has gained
2 valuable work experience in the field of public service while
3 learning more about the legislative process and the issues facing
4 citizens of the Lone Star State; now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 83rd Texas
6 Legislature hereby commend Arthur Huggins, Jr., for his service in
7 the office of State Representative Borris Miles as a participant in
8 the Texas Legislative Internship Program and extend to him sincere
9 best wishes for continued success in all his endeavors; and, be it
