R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Members of the Sunset Advisory Commission staff
2 provided vital assistance to the 83rd Texas Legislature in its
3 consideration of Senate Bill 213, the sunset bill for the Texas
4 Board of Criminal Justice, the Texas Department of Criminal
5 Justice, the Windham School District, the Board of Pardons and
6 Paroles, and the Correctional Managed Health Care Committee; and

7 WHEREAS, Established in 1977, the Sunset Advisory Commission
8 periodically reviews the policies and programs of more than 150
9 government agencies, with the goal of identifying and eliminating
10 waste, duplication, and inefficiency; in addition to questioning

12 might improve operations and activities; and

13 WHEREAS, Under the leadership of Sunset Commission agency
14 director Ken Levine, team members responsible for review of these
15 criminal justice agencies include Jennifer Jones, project manager
16 and supervisor, Joseph Reed, analyst, Eric Beverly, analyst, Faye
17 Rencher, analyst, and Dawn Roberson, administrative staff; they
18 each demonstrated the utmost professionalism in connection with the
19 consideration of S.B. 213, and their extraordinary thoroughness,
20 expertise, and willingness to be available at all hours were
21 invaluable during the legislature's deliberations; and

22 WHEREAS, These praiseworthy members of the Sunset Advisory
23 Commission staff uphold high standards of public service, and
24 through their exceptional skill and dedication, they have

1 contributed immeasurably to the efficiency and accountability of
2 state government; now, therefore, be it
