

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Students from Midway Middle School in Hewitt have
2 earned a number of honors in the 2013 Texas History Day competition;
3 and

4 WHEREAS, Part of National History Day, Texas History Day is a
5 yearlong program that offers students an opportunity to develop
6 research and critical thinking skills while gaining deeper
7 historical knowledge; students who take part in the program conduct
8 research on a particular topic and then present what they have
9 learned in one of a variety of forms, which range from papers,
10 performances, and exhibits to documentaries and interpretive
11 websites; district and regional History Day contests culminate in
12 the statewide fair at the end of the school year; the theme for the
13 2013 competition was "Turning Points in History: People, Ideas,
14 Events"; and

15 WHEREAS, At the Heart of Texas Regional History Fair, held at
16 Baylor University on February 14 and 15, Midway students excelled
17 in both the individual and group events; in the individual exhibit
18 category, Nathaniel Morgan received first place and Henry Beard
19 took second; in the group exhibit division, Will Hilliard and
20 Cameron Russell took first place and also received awards from the
21 Daughters of the American Revolution and the Colonial Dames of
22 America, while Caroline Howell, Rachel Howell, Morgan Howell, and
23 Zoe Recks claimed second place and Joe Micus and Tyler Whitley
24 earned honorable mention; in the historical papers division, Phoebe

1 Park took second place, Ally Brown took third, and Miriam McCormick
2 received honorable mention; and

3 WHEREAS, Midway students garnered additional awards at the
4 statewide contest, which was held at the Bob Bullock Texas State
5 History Museum and at The University of Texas at Austin on May 3 and
6 4; during that event, Henry Beard was singled out for
7 "distinguished achievement" for his individual exhibit,
8 "Gyroscopes and Apollo Three Axis of Rotational Turning," and
9 Nathaniel Morgan was similarly cited for his project, "Battle of
10 Little Bighorn: The Indians' Last Stand"; in the historical paper
11 division, Phoebe Park earned distinguished achievement
12 acknowledgment for her paper, "Kindertransport: A Turning Point in
13 the British Immigration Policy as the Unprecedented Rescue
14 Mission," for which she also received a Jewish History Award; and

15 WHEREAS, In addition to the students' impressive
16 performances, Midway teacher Leaslie Deville was honored at the
17 regional contest with the Calvin B. Smith Award, which is presented
18 each year to a teacher who excels in preparing students for History
19 Day competition; fellow teachers Shelby Milam and Vicki Adams also
20 played an essential role in helping their students attain
21 recognition; and

22 WHEREAS, Many hours of hard work have paid off for these
23 talented young Texans and their teachers, and they are a great
24 source of pride to their school and their community; now,
25 therefore, be it
