- 1 WHEREAS, For nearly a century, the Richardson Community Band
- 2 has been entertaining the people of Richardson, and for the past 30
- 3 years, conductor George W. Jones has led the band with skill and
- 4 distinction; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Founded as the Richardson Community Brass Band in
- 6 the mid-1910s, the ensemble quickly became an essential part of the
- 7 community, regularly performing on the bandstand near East Main and
- 8 McKinney Streets; discontinued during both World Wars, the band was
- 9 started up again in 1970 by Joe Frank, the director of the
- 10 Richardson High School Band; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Today, the group's 60 volunteers represent all walks
- 12 of life, from college students and teachers to business owners and
- 13 retirees, and they vary from beginners to players with four decades
- 14 of experience, all striving for the highest standard of
- 15 musicianship; committed to promoting the rich repertoire of the
- 16 brass and woodwind instruments, the band ends each of its concerts
- 17 with a piece by John Philip Sousa, and over the years they have
- 18 performed 125 of his 136 marches; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Conductor George W. Jones first worked with the band
- 20 as the summer replacement conductor in 1977, and he was permanently
- 21 appointed conductor in 1983; over the course of his exemplary
- 22 tenure, the band has grown in both ambition and acclaim; notably,
- 23 Mr. Jones began the series of outdoor concerts which has since
- 24 become an especially popular summer activity for families

- 1 throughout the region; and
- 2 WHEREAS, A music graduate of Illinois Wesleyan University and
- 3 Southern Methodist University, Mr. Jones was a band director at
- 4 several schools in the Garland Independent School District for many
- 5 years, and since 1997, he has served as the district's director of
- 6 fine arts; in 2010, he was presented with the Richardson
- 7 Coalition's Real Heroes Award; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The community ensembles of Texas add to the cultural
- 9 richness and diversity of the Lone Star State, and the Richardson
- 10 Community Band has long delighted audiences from across the
- 11 Dallas/Fort Worth Metroplex; now, therefore, be it
- 12 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 83rd Texas
- 13 Legislature hereby commend conductor George W. Jones and the
- 14 members of the Richardson Community Band for their artistic
- 15 contributions and extend to them sincere best wishes for continued
- 16 success and happiness; and, be it further
