

R E S O L U T I O N

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of  
2 Texas, 83rd Legislature, Regular Session, 2013, That House Rule 13,  
3 Section 9(a), be suspended in part as provided by House Rule 13,  
4 Section 9(f), to enable the conference committee appointed to  
5 resolve the differences on Senate Bill 1017 (the funding for and  
6 administration of travel information operations by the Texas  
7 Department of Transportation) to consider and take action on the  
8 following matter:

9 House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(1), is suspended to permit the  
10 committee to change text not in disagreement in proposed Section 1  
11 of the bill, in added Section 204.003(b), Transportation Code, to  
12 read as follows:

13 (b) The department may:

14 (1) enter into an agreement with:

15 (A) another state agency for the operation of a  
16 travel information center; or

17 (B) a local government, including a commission  
18 created under Chapter 391, Local Government Code, for the operation  
19 of a travel information center that is located within the  
20 boundaries of the local government; and

21 (2) issue a request for proposals to private or  
22 nonprofit entities for the operation of a travel information  
23 center.
