RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of Texas, 83rd Legislature, Regular Session, 2013, That House Rule 13, Section 9(a), be suspended in part as provided by House Rule 13, Section 9(f), to enable the conference committee appointed to resolve the differences on House Bill 3793 (powers, duties, and services of entities serving counties and county residents) to consider and take action on the following matters:

8 (1) House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(4), is suspended to permit 9 the committee to add text on a matter which is not included in 10 either the house or senate version of the bill by adding the 11 following new SECTION to the bill:

12 SECTION 2. Section 533.0354, Health and Safety Code, is 13 amended by adding Subsections (a-1), (a-2), and (b-1) to read as 14 follows:

15 (a-1) In addition to the services required under Subsection (a) and using money appropriated for that purpose or money received 16 under the Texas Health Care Transformation and Quality Improvement 17 Program 1115 waiver, a local mental health authority may ensure, to 18 19 the extent feasible, the provision of assessment services, crisis services, and intensive and comprehensive services using disease 20 21 management practices for children with serious emotional, behavioral, or mental disturbance not described by Subsection (a) 22 and adults with severe mental illness who are experiencing 23 24 significant functional impairment due to a mental health disorder

(b) Section 533.0354, Health and Safety Code, as amended bythis Act, takes effect January 1, 2014.

Explanation: This addition to the effective date provision of the bill is necessary to reflect the change made by the addition of SECTION 2 to the bill.
