- 1 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of 2 Texas, 83rd Legislature, Regular Session, 2013, That House Rule 13, Section 9(a), be suspended in part as provided by House Rule 13, 3 Section 9(f), to enable the conference committee appointed to 4 5 resolve the differences on Senate Bill 7 (improving the delivery and quality of certain health and human services, including the 6 7 delivery and quality of Medicaid acute care services and long-term services and supports) to consider and take action on the following 8
- (1) House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(4), is suspended to permit the committee to add text on a matter which is not included in either the house or senate version of the bill by adding proposed SECTION 2.03 to ARTICLE 2 of the bill to read as follows:

- 14 SECTION 2.03. Subchapter A, Chapter 533, Government Code, 15 is amended by adding Section 533.00285 to read as follows:
- Sec. 533.00285. STAR + PLUS QUALITY COUNCIL. (a) The STAR

 + PLUS Quality Council is established to advise the commission on

 the development of policy recommendations that will ensure eligible

 recipients receive quality, person-centered, consumer-directed

 acute care services and long-term services and supports in an

 integrated setting under the STAR + PLUS Medicaid managed care

 program.
- 23 (b) The executive commissioner shall appoint the members of 24 the council, who must be stakeholders from the acute care services

- 1 and long-term services and supports community, including:
- 2 (1) representatives of health and human services
- 3 agencies;
- 4 (2) recipients under the STAR + PLUS Medicaid managed
- 5 care program;
- 6 (3) representatives of advocacy groups representing
- 7 <u>individuals with disabilities and seniors who are recipients under</u>
- 8 the STAR + PLUS Medicaid managed care program;
- 9 <u>(4) representatives of service providers for</u>
- 10 individuals with disabilities; and
- 11 (5) representatives of health maintenance
- 12 organizations.
- 13 (c) The executive commissioner shall appoint the presiding
- 14 officer of the council.
- 15 (d) The council shall meet at least quarterly or more
- 16 frequently if the presiding officer determines that it is necessary
- 17 to carry out the responsibilities of the council.
- 18 (e) Not later than November 1 of each year, the council in
- 19 coordination with the commission shall submit a report to the
- 20 executive commissioner that includes:
- 21 (1) an analysis and assessment of the quality of acute
- 22 care services and long-term services and supports provided under
- 23 the STAR + PLUS Medicaid managed care program;
- 24 (2) recommendations regarding how to improve the
- 25 quality of acute care services and long-term services and supports
- 26 provided under the program; and
- 27 (3) recommendations regarding how to ensure that

- 1 recipients eligible to receive services and supports under the
- 2 program receive person-centered, consumer-directed care in the
- 3 most integrated setting achievable.
- 4 (f) Not later than December 1 of each even-numbered year,
- 5 the commission, in consultation with the council, shall submit a
- 6 report to the legislature regarding the assessments and
- 7 recommendations contained in any report submitted by the council
- 8 under Subsection (e) during the most recent state fiscal biennium.
- 9 (g) The council is subject to the requirements of Chapter
- 10 551.
- 11 (h) A member of the council serves without compensation.
- 12 (i) On January 1, 2017:
- 13 (1) the council is abolished; and
- 14 (2) this section expires.
- 15 Explanation: The change is necessary to establish the STAR +
- 16 PLUS Quality Council and provide for the operation and duties of the
- 17 council.
- 18 (2) House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(4), is suspended to permit
- 19 the committee to add text on a matter which is not included in
- 20 either the house or senate version of the bill by adding proposed
- 21 SECTION 2.13 to ARTICLE 2 of the bill to read as follows:
- SECTION 2.13. (a) Not later than October 1, 2013, the
- 23 executive commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission
- 24 shall appoint the members of the STAR + PLUS Quality Council as
- 25 required by Section 533.00285, Government Code, as added by this
- 26 article.
- 27 (b) The STAR + PLUS Quality Council, in coordination with

- 1 the Health and Human Services Commission, shall submit:
- 2 (1) the initial report required under Subsection (e),
- 3 Section 533.00285, Government Code, as added by this article, not
- 4 later than November 1, 2014; and
- 5 (2) the final report required under that subsection
- 6 not later than November 1, 2016.
- 7 (c) The Health and Human Services Commission shall submit:
- 8 (1) the initial report required under Subsection (f),
- 9 Section 533.00285, Government Code, as added by this article, not
- 10 later than December 1, 2014; and
- 11 (2) the final report required under that subsection
- 12 not later than December 1, 2016.
- 13 Explanation: The change is necessary to ensure the
- 14 appointment of members to the STAR + PLUS Quality Council by October
- 15 1, 2013, and to establish the dates by which certain reports
- 16 required under Section 533.00285, Government Code, must be
- 17 submitted by the council and by the Health and Human Services
- 18 Commission.
- 19 (3) House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(4), is suspended to permit
- 20 the committee to add text on a matter which is not included in
- 21 either the house or senate version of the bill by adding proposed
- 22 SECTION 2.16 to ARTICLE 2 of the bill to read as follows:
- SECTION 2.16. Not later than September 15, 2013, the
- 24 governor, lieutenant governor, and speaker of the house of
- 25 representatives shall appoint the members of the STAR + PLUS
- 26 Nursing Facility Advisory Committee as required by Section
- 27 533.00252, Government Code, as added by this article.

- 1 Explanation: The change is necessary to ensure the
- 2 appointment of members to the STAR + PLUS Nursing Facility Advisory
- 3 Committee by September 15, 2013.
