- 6 nine children, he lived with his family in Para, India, until the
- 7 age of 10, when he moved to Pakistan to attend school while staying
- 8 with his brother and sister-in-law; he continued his education at
- 9 some of the premier technical academies in the country during his
- 10 high school and college years; and
- WHEREAS, In 1972, Mr. Khan immigrated to the United States to
- 12 attend North Central Texas College, and after completing an
- 13 associate's degree, he moved to Dallas and began working as a
- 14 manager of a Schepps Food Store; there, he met his future wife,
- 15 Loretta, and the pair exchanged vows in 1976; they shared a
- 16 rewarding union of more than 35 years, which over time was further
- 17 blessed with two children, Sami and Sarah; and
- WHEREAS, Two years after their wedding, Mr. and Mrs. Khan
- 19 relocated to Durant, Oklahoma, where he entered Southeastern
- 20 Oklahoma State University and subsequently earned a degree in
- 21 industrial technology; he then returned to Dallas and continued to
- 22 build on his knowledge by taking courses in computer science; in the
- 23 early 1980s, his technical skills won him a job as a mainframe
- 24 programmer at Dedman Memorial Hospital, now known as Dallas Medical

- 2 milestone in his life came in 1983, when he was granted American
- 3 citizenship; and
- WHEREAS, He ended his career as a network engineer in 2004 but
- 5 emerged from retirement four years later to work as a photo
- 6 technician at a Walmart store in The Colony, where he served until
- 7 the time of his death; and
- 8 WHEREAS, A devoted family man, Mr. Khan deeply enjoyed
- 9 spending time with his wife and children, and he was delighted at
- 10 the birth of his granddaughter, Sophie, in 2010; he was known for
- 11 his charming demeanor, intelligence, sense of humor, and
- 12 generosity, and his favorite pastimes included watching Hollywood
- 13 movies and Korean soap operas and cheering on his favorite teams,
- 14 the Cowboys and Mavericks; and
- WHEREAS, Through his hard work and determination, Dabir Khan
- 16 led a life that exemplified the American dream, and he will always
- 17 be remembered with great fondness and admiration by all those who
- 18 were fortunate enough to share in his love and friendship; now,
