1 WHEREAS, St. Alcuin Montessori School in Dallas is
2 celebrating the 50th anniversary of its founding in 2014; and

3 WHEREAS, Established in 1964 by Episcopal priest Albert
4 Taliaferro, St. Alcuin Montessori originally operated as
5 Montessori School of Dallas, offering classes out of a home in
6 Highland Park for nearly 70 preschool-age children; now located on
7 a picturesque 12-acre campus, the institution has expanded to
8 include toddler, primary, and elementary programs, as well as an
9 International Baccalaureate Middle Years Programme for the sixth,
10 seventh, and eighth grades; and

11 WHEREAS, St. Alcuin Montessori seeks to develop innovative
12 thinkers and passionate learners; faculty members, many of whom are
13 trained abroad at the Association Montessori Internationale,
14 engage their charges by challenging and nurturing them as they
15 develop self-confidence, competency, imagination, and the desire
16 to lead lives of positive influence; and

17 WHEREAS, For half a century, the teachers and staff of St.
18 Alcuin Montessori School have committed themselves to meeting the
19 educational needs of their students, and the school has played a
20 vital role in helping many young Texans build a bright and
21 prosperous future; now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 83rd Texas
23 Legislature hereby commemorate the 50th anniversary of the founding
24 of St. Alcuin Montessori School and extend to all those associated
