4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 61.059, Education Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsections (p) and (q) to read as follows:
7	(p) In its instruction and operations formula applicable to
8	an institution of higher education, the board may not include any
9	semester credit hours earned for dual course credit by a high school
10	student for high school and college credit at the institution
11	unless those credit hours are earned through any of the following:
12	(1) a course in the core curriculum of the institution
13	providing course credit;
14	(2) a career and technical education course that
15	applies to any certificate or associate's degree offered by the
16	institution providing course credit; or
17	(3) a foreign language course.
18	(q) Subsection (p) does not apply to a course completed by a
19	student as part of the early college education program established
20	under Section 29.908.
21	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
22	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
23	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
24	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
