A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to transitional living assistance and appropriate care
- 3 settings for children with disabilities who reside in general
- 4 residential operations.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 531.0244, Government Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsection (c-1) to read as follows:
- 8 <u>(c-1)</u> For purposes of determining the appropriateness of
- 9 transfers under Subsection (b)(3) and developing the strategies
- 10 required by Subsection (b)(4), a health and human services agency
- 11 shall presume the eligibility of a child residing in a general
- 12 residential operation, as defined by Section 42.002, Human
- 13 Resources Code, for transfer to an appropriate community-based
- 14 setting.
- 15 SECTION 2. Subdivision (1), Subsection (a), Section
- 16 531.059, Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 17 (1) "Institutional housing" means:
- 18 (A) an ICF-MR, as defined by Section 531.002,
- 19 Health and Safety Code;
- 20 (B) a nursing facility;
- 21 (C) a state hospital, state school, or state
- 22 center maintained and managed by the Texas Department of Mental
- 23 Health and Mental Retardation; [or]
- (D) an institution for the mentally retarded

- 1 licensed or operated by the Department of Family and Protective
- 2 [and Regulatory] Services; or
- 3 (E) a general residential operation, as defined
- 4 by Section 42.002, Human Resources Code.
- 5 SECTION 3. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 6 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 7 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 8 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 9 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 10 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
