- 1 SECTION 3. If before implementing any provision of this Act a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a 2 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 4 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the 5
- 6 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 10
- Act takes effect September 1, 2013. 11
