5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Chapter 533, Subchapter A, Government Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 533.00251 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 533.00251. BEHAVIORAL HEALTH AND PHYSICAL HEALTH
9	SERVICES NETWORK. (a) The executive commissioner shall integrate
10	behavioral health services, including targeted case management and
11	psychiatric rehabilitation services, and physical health services
12	to persons eligible for such services under the Medicaid program
13	using the managed care organizations contracted to the commission
14	pursuant to Chapter 533, Government Code.
15	(b) The managed care organizations contracted to the
16	commission shall develop a network of providers of behavioral
17	health services.
18	(c) In complying with this section, the executive
19	commissioner shall ensure that:

- 20 (1) An appropriate assessment tool is used to
- 21 <u>authorize services;</u>
- 22 (2) Providers are well-qualified and able to provide
- 23 <u>an appropriate array of services; and</u>
- 24 (3) Appropriate performance and quality outcomes are

- 1 measured.
- 2 (d) This section does not apply to the NorthSTAR Medicaid
- 3 <u>Demonstration Waiver.</u>
- 4 (e) For purposes of this section, "behavioral health
- 5 <u>services" means mental health and substance use disorder services.</u>
- 6 (f) To the extent of any conflict, this section prevails
- 7 over any other law relating to mental and behavioral health care.
- 8 SECTION 2. Integration of behavioral health and physical
- 9 health services as required by SECTION 1 must be completed by
- 10 September 1, 2014.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
