4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Sections 264.502(b) and (c), Family Code, are
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(b) The members of the committee who serve under Subsections
8	(a)(1) through (3) shall select the following additional committee
9	members:
10	(1) a criminal prosecutor involved in prosecuting
11	crimes against children;
12	(2) a sheriff;
13	(3) a justice of the peace;
14	(4) a medical examiner;
15	(5) a police chief;
16	(6) a pediatrician experienced in diagnosing and
17	treating child abuse and neglect;
18	(7) a child educator;
19	(8) a child mental health provider;
20	(9) a public health professional;
21	(10) a child protective services specialist;
22	(11) a sudden infant death syndrome family service
23	provider;
24	(12) a neonatologist;

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- a child advocate; 1 (13)2 (14)a chief juvenile probation officer; 3 (15)a child abuse prevention specialist; 4 (16)a representative of the Department of Public 5 Safety; [and] 6 (17)a representative of the Texas Department of 7 Transportation;
- 8 (18) an emergency medical services provider; and
- 9 <u>(19) a provider of services to, or advocate for,</u>
- 10 victims of family violence.
- 11 (c) Members of the committee selected under Subsection (b)
- 12 serve three-year terms with the terms of [<del>five or</del>] six <u>or seven</u>
- 13 members, as appropriate, expiring February 1 each year.
- 14 SECTION 2. The members of the child fatality review team
- 15 committee under Section 264.502(a), Family Code, responsible for
- 16 selecting the additional members of the committee required by
- 17 Section 264.502(b), Family Code, as amended by this Act, shall make
- 18 those appointments not later than November 1, 2013.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
