A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-21 relating to a request for a waiver of the waiting period before 1-22 human remains may be cremated.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 716.004, Health and Safety Code, is amended by adding Subsection (b) to read as follows:

(b) The county medical examiner, or, in counties that do not have a county medical examiner, justices of the peace, shall develop and maintain a written policy for requesting a written waiver of the 48-hour waiting period before cremation. In developing the policy, the medical examiner or justices of the peace shall consider how persons may make a request, the availability to make a request on weekends or holidays, and other issues relevant to processing a request as swiftly as possible.

1-34 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-35 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 1-36 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-37 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-38 Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
