1-21 relating to eligibility for compensation of persons wrongfully  
 1-22 imprisoned.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 103.001, Civil Practice and Remedies  
 1-25 Code, is amended by adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:

1-26 (f) A person is not entitled to compensation under  
 1-27 Subsection (a) or group health benefit plan coverage under  
 1-28 Subsection (d) for any part of a sentence in prison during which the  
 1-29 person was also serving a concurrent sentence for another wrongful  
 1-30 conviction for which the person has already received compensation  
 1-31 under Subsection (a) or group health plan coverage under Subsection  
 1-32 (d).

1-33 SECTION 2. Section 103.003, Civil Practice and Remedies  
 1-34 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-35 Sec. 103.003. LIMITATION ON TIME TO FILE. (a) A person  
 1-36 seeking compensation under this chapter must file an application  
 1-37 with the comptroller for compensation under Subchapter B not later  
 1-38 than the third anniversary of the date:

1-39 (1) the person on whose imprisonment the claim is  
 1-40 based received a pardon as provided by Section 103.001(a)(2)(A);

1-41 (2) the person's application for a writ of habeas  
 1-42 corpus was granted as provided by Section 103.001(a)(2)(B); or

1-43 (3) an order of dismissal described by Section  
 1-44 103.001(a)(2)(C) was signed.

1-45 (b) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), a person seeking  
 1-46 compensation under this chapter who received the pardon or was  
 1-47 granted relief as described by Subsection (a) before September 1,  
 1-48 1998, may file an application with the comptroller for compensation  
 1-49 under Subchapter B not later than September 1, 2016. This  
 1-50 subsection expires September 2, 2016.

1-51 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
