5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subdivision (3), Section 2161.001, Government
7	Code, is amended to read as follows:
8	(3) "Economically disadvantaged person" means a
9	person who <u>:</u>
10	(A) is economically disadvantaged because of the
11	person's identification as a member of a certain group, including <u>:</u>
12	<u>(i)</u> Black Americans <u>;</u>
13	<u>(ii)</u> [-] Hispanic Americans <u>;</u>
14	<u>(iii)</u> [,] women <u>;</u>
15	<u>(iv)</u> [$_{\tau}$] Asian Pacific Americans <u>;</u>
16	$(v)[\tau \text{ and}]$ Native Americans; $[\tau]$ and
17	(vi) veterans as defined by 38 U.S.C.
18	Section 101(2) who have suffered at least a 20 percent
19	service-connected disability as defined by 38 U.S.C. Section
20	101(16); and
21	(B) [who] has suffered the effects of
22	discriminatory practices or other similar insidious circumstances
23	over which the person has no control.
24	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.

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
