A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the creation of certain funding formulas and policies
- 3 and to certain public health evaluations by the Department of State
- 4 Health Services.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 1001, Health and Safety
- 7 Code, is amended by adding Sections 1001.078 and 1001.079 to read as
- 8 follows:

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- 9 Sec. 1001.078. FUNDING FORMULA; PUBLIC HEALTH EVALUATION.
- 10 (a) In this section:
- 11 (1) "Health service region" means a public health
- 12 region designated under Section 121.007.
- 13 (2) "Local health department" means a local health
- 14 <u>department established under Subchapter D, Chapter 121.</u>
- 15 (3) "Local health unit" has the meaning assigned by
- 16 Section 121.004.
- 17 (4) "Public health district" means a health district
- 18 established under Subchapter E, Chapter 121.
- 19 (b) The department, in collaboration with the Public Health
- 20 Funding and Policy Committee established under Section 117.051,
- 21 shall:
- (1) develop funding formulas for federal and state
- 23 <u>funds</u> appropriated to the department to be allocated to local
- 24 health departments, local health units, public health districts,

- 1 and health service regions' regional headquarters, based on
- 2 population, population density, disease burden, social
- 3 determinants of health, local efforts to prevent disease, and other
- 4 relevant factors as determined by the department and committee;
- 5 (2) evaluate the feasibility and benefits of placing a
- 6 cap on the percentage of public health funds that can be used on
- 7 administrative costs at local health departments, local health
- 8 units, public health districts, and health service regions'
- 9 regional headquarters; and
- 10 (3) evaluate public health functions provided by the
- 11 department, local health departments, local health units, public
- 12 <u>health districts</u>, and health service regions' regional
- 13 headquarters and determine if another entity, including a private
- 14 entity, can provide those functions more effectively.
- Sec. 1001.079. PUBLIC HEALTH THREAT POLICY. (a) In this
- 16 section, "local health department" means a local health department
- 17 <u>established under Subchapter D, Chapter 121.</u>
- 18 (b) The department shall create a policy to allow a local
- 19 health department flexibility, to the extent allowed under federal
- 20 law, in the use of personnel and other resources during disaster
- 21 response activities, outbreaks, and other appropriate public
- 22 <u>health threats.</u>
- 23 SECTION 2. Not later than October 1, 2014, the Department of
- 24 State Health Services shall:
- 25 (1) develop the funding formulas required by
- 26 Subdivision (1), Subsection (b), Section 1001.078, Health and
- 27 Safety Code, as added by this Act;

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- 1 (2) submit to the governor, the lieutenant governor,
- 2 the speaker of the house of representatives, and appropriate
- 3 standing committees of the legislature a report on the findings
- 4 required by Subdivisions (2) and (3), Subsection (b), Section
- 5 1001.078, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act; and
- 6 (3) create the policy required by Section 1001.079,
- 7 Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
