- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 1001, Health and Safety
- 7 Code, is amended by adding Sections 1001.078 and 1001.079 to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 Sec. 1001.078. FUNDING FORMULA; PUBLIC HEALTH EVALUATION.
- 10 (a) In this section:
- 11 (1) "Health service region" means a public health
- 12 region designated under Section 121.007.
- 13 (2) "Local health department" means a local health
- 14 department established under Subchapter D, Chapter 121.
- 15 (b) The department, in collaboration with the Public Health
- 16 Funding and Policy Committee established under Section 117.051,
- 17 shall:
- (1) develop funding formulas for federal and state
- 19 funds appropriated to the department to be allocated to local
- 20 <u>health departments</u> and health service regions' regional
- 21 headquarters, based on population, population density, disease
- 22 <u>burden</u>, <u>social determinants of health</u>, <u>local efforts to prevent</u>
- 23 disease, and other relevant factors as determined by the department
- 24 and committee;

- 1 (2) evaluate the feasibility and benefits of placing a
- 2 cap on the percentage of public health funds that can be used on
- 3 administrative costs at local health departments and health service
- 4 regions' regional headquarters; and
- 5 (3) evaluate public health functions provided by the
- 6 department, health service regions' regional headquarters, and
- 7 local health departments and determine if another entity, including
- 8 <u>a private entity</u>, can provide those functions more effectively.
- 9 Sec. 1001.079. PUBLIC HEALTH THREAT POLICY. (a) In this
- 10 section, "local health department" means a local health department
- 11 established under Subchapter D, Chapter 121.
- 12 (b) The department shall create a policy to allow a local
- 13 health department flexibility, to the extent allowed under federal
- 14 law, in the use of personnel and other resources during disaster
- 15 response activities, outbreaks, and other appropriate public
- 16 health threats.
- SECTION 2. Not later than October 1, 2014, the Department of
- 18 State Health Services shall:
- 19 (1) develop the funding formulas required by Section
- 20 1001.078(b)(1), Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act;
- 21 (2) submit to the governor, the lieutenant governor,
- 22 the speaker of the house of representatives, and appropriate
- 23 standing committees of the legislature a report on the findings
- 24 required by Sections 1001.078(b)(2) and (3), Health and Safety
- 25 Code, as added by this Act; and
- 26 (3) create the policy required by Section 1001.079,
- 27 Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act.

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1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2013.
